After an absence of 4 years Vallance FC are back competing in the BFA Summer League where it all began in 1997. The team will comprise mostly of U18 players mixed with a few senior players. The games will take place at Victoria Park and will kick off in May 2014 and completed by August 2014.

Manager Junel Uddin said "We feel it is time again to put Vallance FC back in the BFA Summer League because the players wanted it again. We pulled out in 2009 because we just entered the first team in the Middlesex County Football League and we thought players need a rest during summer. Now we have a good blend of young players coming through to mix with the senior boys and this will be a good Pre Season warm up before the winter leagues start in September 2014".

Vallance FC have their youth teams playing in the BFA Youth Summer League for the past 5 years and this summer they will have a U16, U14, U12 and U10 competing again.

During the February 2014 half term school holidays Vallance CSA in partnership with the **MAYP** (Mayors Activities for Young People) held a week long programme.
